

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Privacy Notice

This notice is applicable to all employees employed by this company and all those otherwise engaged to work as part of the workforce of this company.

How we use your information

We process personal data relating to those we employ to work as, or are otherwise engaged to work within our workforce. We do this is for employment purposes, to assist in the running of the company and/or to enable individuals to be paid.

This information is also used to:-

Changes to our privacy policy

We will not share information about you with third parties without your consent unless the law allows or requires us to.

Website signups

By 'opting-in' to our mailing list you have agreed to receive email marketing communications from us in the form of updates, offers and competitions. You are free to unsubscribe from our mailing list at any time, simply use the 'unsubscribe' button.

When signing up for our email communications via our website, we require your name and email address to ensure accuracy of delivery. We will never share or sell your personal data or use it for any other purposes besides email marketing. All of your data will only be stored by us online.

Your privacy is paramount to us and the removal or 'unsubscribe' of a user will be added to a suppression list, which will stop us from reaching the user's email address; this will ensure that you will not be communicated by us again until requested via an 'opt-in' form. We will guarantee that there will be no cause for objection or complaint when signing up to our email marketing list and frequency will be set at a maximum of four emails per calendar month.
